

The Kansas Sierra Club urgently requests that you reject the "dirty air" provisions in the National Emergency Energy Act. Specifically, we are opposed to the provisions leaving coal burning power plants free to pollute until 1979, the weakening of transportation pollution controls, and the delay in meeting auto emissions standards.
