Thanks so much for your letter of April 1, and I certainly agree with you concerning the way the present administration is conducting the foreign affairs of our nation.

The Bay of Pigs fiasco is a blot on the good name of this country which could easily have been avoided by a firm, forthright policy. If the proper action had been taken, I am convinced we would not today have a communist beachhead at our doorstep.

Noted your comments with reference to the Burleson-Curtis Resolution. While I am in agreement with the objectives of this legislation, one must remember that the Democrats hold a wide margin in both the House and Senate, and the leadership is subservient to the Kennedy administration. In view of this, there is in my opinion little chance they will permit such legislation to come up for consideration and will keep it securely under cover.

It seems to me the best way of returning our country to a sane policy in both the foreign and domestic fields is to elect conservatives to both Congress and the Presidency in the next election, and those dedicated to the conservative philosophy should work as never before toward this end.
