In an editorial page feature story in Monday's Topeka Daily Capital, Robert S Allen & Paul Scott told there is definite evidence that 3 large missile sites are definitely under construction in Cuba - that the U.S. is not conducting aerial flights over the construction before completion of Cuban refugee pickup.

If this is true as reported, then it would appear to me the Representatives should be a lot more concerned over the future safety of several million Americans than a few thousand Cuban refugees.

In my opinion, a naval blockade would shut off the flow of materials to these sites.
