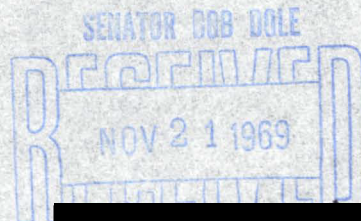
I've watched many T.V. specials on the slaughter of wild life in the U.S. Among one species that seems to be nearing extinction is the wolf.
